James “Connie” Wickizer, 80, of Bluffton died at 9:48 p.m. Saturday, Jan. 27, 2007, at Lutheran Hospital, Fort Wayne.

Mr. Wickizer worked for the C&O Railroad for 40 years, retiring as a foreman in 1989. He was a U.S. Navy veteran with service during World War II. He was a member of Bluffton Church of God and attended high school in English Lake, Indiana.
