Jane Hamilton, 95 of Bluffton, passed away on Saturday afternoon, May 18, 2024, at River Terrace Estates in Bluffton.

Jane was born on May 31, 1928, in Liberty Center, Indiana to Roy Elliot & Maude Mae (Kingen) Stinson. She graduated from Chester Center High School with the class of 1946 and worked at Caylor-Nickel Clinic for a couple of years, Franklin Electric in Bluffton from 1972, until she retired in 1984, where she worked at the Handy Spot in Bluffton for 10 years.

Jane was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Bluffton, and an active member of the United Methodist Women's Group. Jane enjoyed being a member of the Terrace Jewels, the Red Hatters Group at River Terrace. 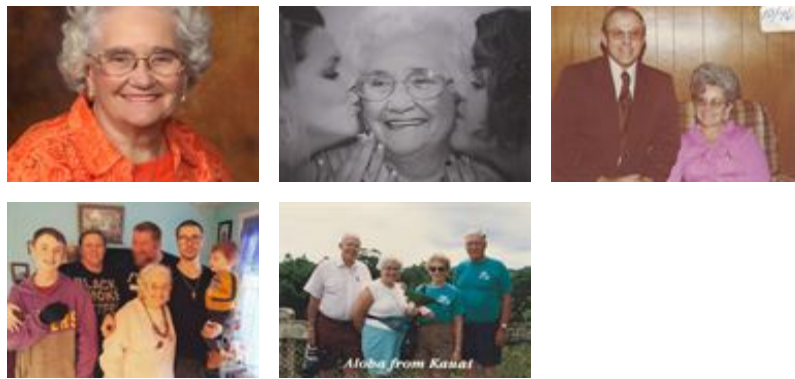
