



Jane A. Patterson Schoeff

July 26, 1915 - March 29, 2008

Jane A. Patterson Schoeff, 92, of Bluffton, died at 4:30 p.m. Saturday, March 29, 2008 at Bluffton Regional Medical Center.

Born in Bluffton on July 26, 1915 to William Dailey and Ethel O. (Jarrett) Bulger, she married twice. Her first husband, Rolland "Pat" Patterson preceded her in death in 1977. Her second husband, Floyd Schoeff, preceded her in death in 1997.

A 1933 graduate of Bluffton High School, Mrs. Schoeff worked at J.C. Penneys in Bluffton from 1933 to 1942. Together with her first husband, she owned and operated the B&K Root Beer Stand from 1959 to 1963, and Miller Motel in Decatur from 1963 to 1970. She was a member of the Home Forum Club and the First Baptist Church in Bluffton.

Surviving relatives include one daughter, Vicki (Steve) Studebaker of Bluffton; one son, Douglas B. (Joy) Patterson of Bluffton; four grandchildren, 11 great-grandchildren and one great-great-grandchild.

Mrs. Schoeff was preceded in death by one sister, Mary Uptgraft of Bluffton, and four brothers, Roger, Tom, Bill and Bob Bulger.

Funeral services will be at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday, at the Thoma/Rich, Chaney and Lemler Funeral Home in Bluffton, with Pastor Bud Abrams officiating. Calling hours will be from 2 to 8 p.m. Tuesday at the funeral home. Burial is at Elm Grove Cemetery, in Bluffton.

Preferred memorials are to the Wells County Boys and Girls Club.

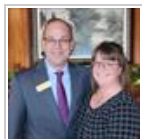

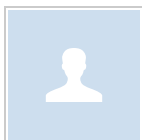
