Janet Heller, 85 of Bluffton passed away at 10:50 p.m. on Thursday, March 31, 2016, at Bluffton Regional Medical Center.

Janet was born on September 29, 1930 in Wells County to John H. "Jack" Lamson & Norma (Kain) Lamson-Larmore. She graduated from Bluffton High School in 1948 and lived in Wells County until 1988, when she retired from the Wells/Adams Credit Bureau. She then moved to North Carolina and worked at Haywood Community College for 11 years. She returned to Bluffton in 2003, where she was a 30 year active member of Psi Iota Xi sorority serving two terms as President. She was a lifelong learner who loved music, reading and enjoyed nature. Janet attended the First Church of Christ in Bluffton.

Janet's first marriage was to William "Bill" Wolfcale, Jr. and he preceded her in death. She later married Donald W. Heller, who also preceded her in death. Survivors include her children: Linda (John) Deming of Fort Wayne, Beverly (Dwight) Habegger of Berne, Craig (Tami) Wolfcale of Bluffton and step-children: Donald W. (Gale) Heller, Jr. of Markle, Jeffrey A. (Mary) Heller of Michigan and Mark D. Heller of Markle.

“ I met Janet at HRD Haywood Community College when I worked there from 1996 to 1999. Those three years with Janet and our boss Carolyn Holcomb (also now passed onto her eternal reward) were three of the best and pivotal years of my life. I worked as an instructor, a completely new position; I was a newly divorced mother of a two-year-old at 36, slightly overwhelmed and confused. Carolyn took me on, as Janet would later say of herself, and loved and mentored me. Janet stood by as a steadfast encourager.

Carolyn was the sparky Southern mentor mom I never had. Janet was the warmth, wit and wisdom of my own Midwestern Ohio family, familiar to me, and comforting. She always met any circumstances or chaos (we worked with welfare moms and career-changing mid-lifers) with the same even temperament and that beautiful smile; she always had a simple anecdote or clever observation that brought a new level of appreciation to all our daily work lives. She always gave a gift to my son on his birthday. In fact I recently found a thank-you note he wrote twenty years ago and I never sent. It was sitting on my coffee table when I got the news of her passing. A missed opportunity. But that is what she reminded me of, not to miss opportunities to bless and remember people, particularly on their special days. Sometimes we would chat on the phone and she would tell me she had travel brochures spread all over her bed, and she was “traveling.” Simple pleasures and dreaming, all the while living her daily life as such a precious thing. It is difficult to articulate the impact she had on my delicate life during that time, and to this day.

We had in the past few years, reconnected, and shared funny stories about Carolyn and what a special time that was for the three of us. The week before Janet passed on, she sent me newspaper clippings on her town’s centennial. She included notes on my uncle Lew Wallace, remembering some family history I had shared. Even when I did not keep up with her life, she remembered mine. That, dear friends, is how my Jesus behaves, and when He saved my life ten years ago, she celebrated that with me, too.

She was funny, beautiful, wise, warm, sensible and saavy. She is my third friend in this past year, all in their eighties, to pass on, and the last of my "elder" advisors. I will look to her legacy now, to inform my next years, and count it a blessing and privilege to do so. My prayers and thoughts are with her family. I know you will miss her dearly.
