Janet Sue Trubey, 57, Geneva, died at 4:45 a.m. Saturday, Sept. 13, 2008 at Adams Memorial Hospital in Decatur.

Born in Portland on Jan. 11, 1951 to Leo “Gene” and Francis (Davis) Rhodehamel, she married Steven Trubey on October 31, 1980 in Redwood City, Calif.; he survives.

A 1969 graduate of South Adams High School, she earned a Bachelor’s degree from Ball State University in 1974 and worked in social services—the past ten years at Job Works in Bluffton.
