Janice A. Myers, 81, of Keystone, passed away early Monday morning, March 11, 2019.

Mrs. Myers was born in Blackford County, Indiana on November 29, 1937, to Lewis & Mary (Taylor) Dickason. She married Merrill A. Myers in Redkey on April 27, 1954; he preceded her in death on October 21, 2010.
