Jeanette A. Johnson, 93, of Berne, died at 12:22 p.m. Monday, Feb. 8, 2010, at Swiss Village Retirement Community. 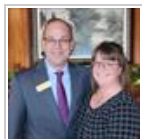

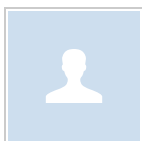
