



## Jessie K. Nash

September 29, 1931 - February 16, 2008

Jessie K. Nash, 76, of Bluffton, died at 3:10 p.m. Saturday, Feb. 16, 2008, at Bluffton Regional Medical Center.

Born in Wabash on Sept. 29, 1931 to Leo and Edith (Gorham) Cassiday, she married Edwin A. Nash in Skeels, Mich. on June 29, 1952; he preceded her in death on Feb. 16, 2003.

A graduate of Wabash High School, Mrs. Nash moved to Wells County in 1965. She was a homemaker, and a member of Sonlight Wesleyan Church.
