JoAnn (Christman) Erhart, 85 of Bronson, Michigan and a former Bluffton resident passed away at 5:55 a.m. Sunday, January 4, 2015 at Community Health Center in Coldwater, Michigan.

JoAnn was born on January 26, 1929 in Bluffton to William Theron and Genevieve Irene (Baker) Christman. On August 29, 1948 in Bluffton, she married Kenneth D. Erhart. He preceded her in death on October 14, 1973.
