John Richard Cupp, 82 of Bluffton, passed away on Sunday morning, November 28, 2021 at Christian Care Retirement Community. He was born on August 21, 1939 in Bluffton to Bob and Margaret (Miller) Cupp. He graduated from Union Center High School in 1957. John delivered fuel oil for Standard Oil for several years, eventually joining National Oil, where he retired in 2014. 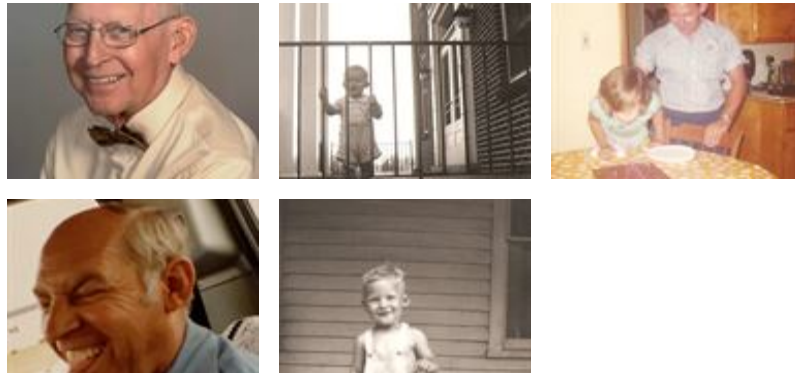
