John H. Prible, 89, of Liberty Center, died at 3:41 p.m. Friday, March 14, 2008, at Bluffton Regional Medical Center.

He was born to C. Forest and Dora A. (Miller) Prible on March 4, 1919, in Liberty Center.

A 1937 graduate of Liberty Center High School, he studied agriculture at Purdue University for three and a half years before being drafted into the U.S. Army Cavalry to serve during World War II. He was a lifelong farmer, but also worked for a few years at J.A. Morris Company in Bluffton. He was a member of VFW Post 2809, American Legion Post 111 and Liberty Center United Methodist Church, where served as pianist for 40 years.

Surviving relatives include two sisters, Esther Prible of Liberty Center and Mary Moses of Fort Wayne; three nephews, David Prible of Bluffton, Larry Prible of Carmel, and Ray Prible of Virginia Beach, Va.; and six nieces, Sara Pursifull of Bluffton, Susie Ellison of Bluffton, Janet Herring of Bluffton, Sandra Bergman of Jerome, Mich., Kathy Denig of Fort Wayne, and Jane Givens of Indianapolis.

He was preceded in death by three brothers, Harold R. Prible, Paul Prible, and Edwin Prible; and one sister, Martha Morris.

Funeral services will be held at 10:30 a.m. Tuesday at Thoma/Rich, Chaney & Lemler Funeral Home. Visitation will be Monday from 2 p.m. to 8 p.m. Burial will be at Mossburg Cemetery. There will be military graveside rites by American Legion Post 111 and the U.S. Army Honor Guard. Pastor Daniel Helm will officiate.

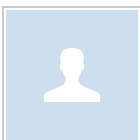
