John Keith Bossert, 75 of Northbrook, Illinois passed away at 10:22 p.m. Tuesday at Lutheran General Hospital in Park Ridge, Illinois.

Born on September 13, 1932 in Liberty, Indiana to Elmer F. & Thelma (Gustavel) Bossert. A graduate of Short High School, he then studied and graduated from Indiana University School of Law. Mr. Bossert practiced law for many years with his father at the Bossert & Toney Law Firm in Liberty, Indiana.

John served his country as a First Lt. in the United States Air Force during the Korean War from 1954 to 1957.

On February 26, 1955 in Bluffton, Indiana he married Joan (Edris) and they have been married for the last 53 years.

A member of the Presbyterian Church in Liberty, Indiana, he also was a member of the Indiana & National Bar Association. He also was a member of the American Legion Post # 122 , and the V.F.W., both in Liberty, Indiana

John became ill with Multiple Sclerosis in 1962 and has not been able to work since that time.

He is survived by his wife Joan, a son John P. Bossert of Issaquah, Washington and a daughter Mrs. Charles "Susan" Kuhn of Glenview, Illinois. He is also survived by three grandchildren: Allison V. Bossert, Carolyn Therese Kuhn and Charles Kuhn, Jr.

A graveside service will be held at Elm Grove Cemetery in Bluffton at a later date.
