



## Jon E. Turner

August 28, 1939 - June 24, 2012

Jon E. Turner 72 of Bluffton passed away at 10:04 a.m. Sunday, June 24, 2012 at Lutheran Hospital in Fort Wayne.

Jon was born on August 28, 1939 in Bluffton to Earl S. & Artha O. (Kline) Turner. He graduated from Bluffton High School in 1957, and followed in his father's and grandfather's footsteps and enrolled in the Indianapolis Master Barber's College graduating in 1958. During college, he made it home on the weekends to see his childhood sweetheart, Pat Spade. On Valentines Day in 1960, Jon & Patricia "Pat" A. Turner were married. They have shared the last 52 years together.

Jon served his country in the United States Army, in the military police. When he returned home he opened Turner's Barber Shop and operated until he retired from Barbering in 1984, after 26 years. He continued to work in security for Peytons, the Caylor-Nickel Clinic and Lutheran Hospital. In 2009 he retired again to focus his time on his family and fishing.

He is survived by his wife Pat of Bluffton, a daughter Kathy (husband Dave) Golden and two grandson, Luke & Mark Golden, all of Zanesville, along with his loyal Tanner Joe "T.J", his dog.

He was a long time member of the First Reformed Church and a 48 year

member of the American Legion Post #111 of Bluffton.
