



## Jordan Thomas Foughty

September 21, 1989 - June 3, 2011

Jordan Thomas Foughty, 21, of Ossian, died Friday, June 3, 2011, as a result of an automobile accident in Wells County.

Jordan was born in Fort Wayne on Sept. 21, 1989, to Curtis D. and Karen A. (Fox) Foughty.

A 2008 graduate of Norwell Jordan worked at Buckhorn. He previously attended Indiana University in Bloomington. He attended Life Community Church, and enjoyed spending time with his friends.

Other surviving relatives include grandparents, Martha Foughty of Ossian, Clifford D and June Ann Fox of Warren; one sister, Courtney Foughty of Indianapolis; and two brothers, Zachary Foughty of Indianapolis and Trevor Foughty of Arlington, Va.

Jordan was also preceded in death by one grandfather, Herman Lloyd Foughty.

Calling hours will be from 1 to 8 p.m. Monday, June 6, and from 10 a.m. to 11 a.m.
