



Joy Dee Thompson

September 25, 1935 - October 10, 2010

A relative of several Wells County residents, Joy Dee Thompson, 75, of Fort Wayne, died at 2:15 a.m. Sunday, Oct. 10, 2010, at Lutheran Hospital as a result of complications from a heart attack. Mr. Thompson was born in Portland on Sept. 25, 1935, to Donald R. and Wanetta Mae (Gallimore) Thompson. He married Bonnie L. McFarren in Wells County on Nov. 8, 1952; she survives. Mr. Thompson attended Portland schools. He worked for Thermtron of Fort Wayne for 30 years and Flickinger Industries of Fort Wayne for 25 years.
