Kathleen "Kathy" Bauman, 58 of Geneva passed away at 9:09 p.m. Monday, December 16, 2013 at Lutheran Hospital in Fort Wayne.

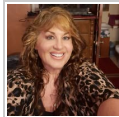

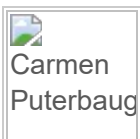
