



Kenneth "Ken" Lee Humphrey

August 27, 1976 - December 13, 2007

The son and brother of Bluffton residents, Kenneth "Ken" Lee Humphrey, 31, of West Unity, Ohio, died Thursday, Dec. 13, 2007, at his residence.

Born in Lexington, Ky. to Wayne Humphrey and Jeanette (Doll) Elsasser on Aug. 27, 1976, he married April D. Strine on Apr. 29, 2000; both parents and his wife survive, the father living in Bluffton and the mother in Kenton, Ohio. Mr. Humphrey attended Pinkerton High School in Ohio. He lived in Bluffton before moving to West Unity.

Other surviving relatives include two daughters, Samantha Jo and Amber Lee Humphrey, both of West Unity; a grandmother, Martha Humphrey of Bluffton, two brothers, Mike and Derick D. Humphrey, both of Bluffton; and one sister, Amy Badertscher of Kenton, Ohio.
