Kenneth L. "Kenny" Hedges, 74, Bluffton, died Sunday, April 15, 2007 at Lutheran Hospital in Fort Wayne.

A native and life-long Bluffton resident, he was born on March 31, 1933 to LeRoy and Vera Kain Hedges and married Judith A. Krinn on June 20, 1954 in Bluffton. She survives. A veteran of the U.S. Navy in the Korean War, he was a 1951 graduate of Bluffton High School and attended Ball State University. He was a member of the First Baptist Church, the VFW and the American Legion Post 111. Mr. Hedges worked at Kitco, Coverall Rental, Erie Railroad and Good Humor Breyers. He was an avid IU and Norwell sports and music fan.
