



## Kenneth Virgil Zoll

October 24, 1936 - July 16, 2007

Kenneth Virgil Zoll, 70, of Greencastle, a former Bluffton resident, died at 12:15 a.m. today, July 16, 2007 at home with his family.

He lived in Wells County for most of his life and resided at 515 West Central Avenue until 2004 when he and his wife moved to Greencastle to be closer to their son. He had worked for Indiana-Michigan Electric, the City of Bluffton, and Red Gold Canning Co. in Bluffton. He was a long time member of the Bluffton Street Fair Board and ran the poultry tent at the fair for many years. He showed poultry and was a member of the America Brown Leghorn Association. He was a former member of the Moose Lodge and attended the First United Methodist Church.

He was born in Wells County on Oct. 24, 1936, a son of Virgil LaVern Zoll and Doris (Bowman) Zoll. He graduated from Bluffton High School. He was married in Bluffton on August 31, 1956 to Ann Lee (Hunt) Zoll, who survives. He is also survived by his mother Doris of Bluffton, his sons Marshall K. Zoll of Greencastle, and Mitchell K. Zoll of Yorktown, and his daughters Michelle K. Harris and Sherry Zoll both of Bluffton, along with his brothers Kim Zoll of Bluffton, and Tim Zoll of Decatur, and a sister Janet Thomas of Bluffton, and nine grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his brother Tom Zoll.
