



## Mr. Larry K. "Fuzzy" Sliger

February 12, 1937 - January 26, 2014

Larry "Fuzzy" K. Sliger, 76 of Bluffton passed away at 11:00 p.m. Sunday, January 26, 2014 at Kindred Nursing & Rehabilitation – Meadowvale.

Larry was born on February 12, 1937 in Wells County to Dwight E. Sliger & Nellie M. (Huss) Sliger. He was a 1955 graduate of P.A. Allen High School. He served his country in the United States Army from 1956 – 1959 in Germany as a Teletype Operator.

He served on the Bluffton Police Department for 6 years. Larry retired from Indiana Dept of Transportation in 2000, after 22 years as a heavy equipment operator and District Operator in the Fort Wayne District. He also operated his own construction company for many years. He enjoyed music and dancing. He was a member of the American Legion Post #111 of Bluffton and a member of Sonlight Wesleyan Church in Bluffton.

Survivors include children; Pansey (Dennis) Bobay of Ossian, Rusty K. Sliger of Fort Wayne along with a grandson, C.J. (Jillian) Fields of Huntington and three great-grandchildren; Trace, Chase & Chance Fields all of Huntington along with siblings; Carolyn (Lou) Van Gorden of Hartford City and Fred (Sue) Sliger of Zanesville, Indiana.

He is preceded in death by three sisters; Louise Robles, Alice Bunch, Wanda Bunch and a brother Donald "Donnie" Sliger.

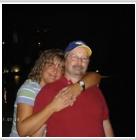
