



Lester O. Sundling

November 18, 1917 - May 27, 2008

Lester O. Sundling, 90, of Bluffton, died Tuesday, May 27, 2008, at 11:10 a.m. at Lutheran Hospital in Fort Wayne.

Born to Oscar and Ida (Oberg) Sundling on Nov. 11, 1917, in Chicago, Ill., after they had immigrated from Sweden, he married Mary E. (Van de Lester) Sundling on Sept. 2, 1949, in Kalamazoo, Mich. She survives him.

A graduate of Lane Tech High School in Chicago, he served in the Army during World War II, and then earned a bachelor of science degree in engineering from the University of Michigan. He worked for 34 years at Corning Glass as a project engineer. He retired March 6, 1989. He was a member of First Presbyterian Church in Bluffton.

Surviving in addition to the wife is a daughter, Peggy (Michael) Oakley of Charlotte, N.C., and three sons, Douglas A. Sundling of Bluffton, Thomas D. (Jennifer) Sundling of Thousand Oaks, Calif., and Kurt W. (Leigh) Sundling of Noblesville. Also surviving are 11 grandchildren.

The body will be cremated.

The family will greet friends from 2 to 5 p.m. Saturday at the Rittenhouse Restaurant at 218 South Main St.
