November 11, 1917 - January 18, 2013

Lila K Mittlestedt, 95, formally of Bluffton passed away at 10 pm Friday, January 18, 2013 at the Good Samaritan Care Center in Kissimmee, Florida.

Lila was born in Curtiss, Wisconsin on November 11, 1917 to Ralph and Alma (Neitzel) Green. She married Alfred E. Mittlestedt on July 2, 1938 and he preceded her in death on October 26, 1987.

Lila was a member of the First Presbyterian Church while living in Bluffton. She and Alfred moved to Ocala FL in 1970 following Alfred's retirement after many years as a supervisor in maintenance at Franklin Electric. Following Alfred's death she moved to Good Samaritan Retirement Village in 2008 to be near her son in Davenport FL where she resided at the time of her death.
