Lillian M. George, 84 of Bluffton passed away at 1:00 a.m. Wednesday, February 4, 2009 at Bluffton Regional Medical Center in Bluffton, Indiana.

Lillian was born on January 9, 1925 in Fort Wayne, Indiana to Arthur E. and Marvel E. (McClymonds) Kesler.

On June 7, 1947 at Fort Wayne, Indiana she married Kermit H. George. They have been married for over 61 years. Lillian and Kermit have lived in Bluffton since July 4, 1950.

She graduated from Fort Wayne Central High School in 1942, where she excelled in academics "National Honor's Society" and athletics. After high school and additional training she worked at Lincoln National Life Insurance as a secretary for 8 years, and Franklin Electric for 2 years. Lillian then worked as a secretary for the First United Methodist Church in Bluffton, where she was a 55 years member. She retired due to eyesight difficulties and had partial vision for 30 years, and has been completely blind for the last 20 years.

Lillian is survived by her husband of Kermit of Bluffton, a sister Mrs. Dwight "Shirley" Thomason of Denver, Colorado. She is also survived by a brother-in-law; Kenneth George of Bluffton, and two sister-in-laws; Mrs. John "Janice" Searle of Perrysburg, Ohio and Mrs. Donald "Vivien" Hills of Torrington,

Wyoming.

She is preceded in death by her parents.

Funeral services for Lillian will be held at 10:30 a.m. Saturday, February 7, 2009 at the First United Methodist Church in Bluffton, with calling hours for one hour prior to the service at the church.
