Lillie A. Lobsiger, 90, of Bluffton, died at 6:55 a.m. today, July 6, 2007, at Meadowvale Health and Rehab Center. Born in Cadillac, Mich., to Kelly and Rosa (Bryant) Powers on November 13, 1916, she married Loren N. Lobsiger on April 21, 1934 in LaGrange. He preceded her in death on May 31, 2005. A founding member of Hope Missionary Church, Mrs. Lobsiger was an LPN and had worked at Caylor-Nickel Hospital. She worked as a bookkeeper for Loren's Body Shop, a family business owned and operated by her and her husband for 25 years.
