



Linn E. Gregg

May 25, 1924 - March 1, 2007

A resident of Ossian, Linn E. Gregg, 82, died at 7:15 p.m. Thursday, March 1, 2007, at Ossian Health & Rehabilitation Center.

Born May 25, 1924 to Linn and Nellie (Jamison) Gregg, he married the former Betty J. James in Bluffton Dec. 24, 1942. She survives.

A 1942 graduate of Bluffton High School, he was a United States Navy veteran serving in both WW II and Korea. He was in management at Magnavox in Fort Wayne for 18 years, retiring in 1974. He later worked for the Indiana Department of Highways for eight years retiring in 1990. A member of the American Legion Post #111, he was a past Vice-Commander, past Post Commander and past District Commander. He was a member of the Masonic Lodge, Bluffton Eastern Star, Fort Wayne Scottish Rite, Magnavox Management Club, and past president of the Ossian Lions Club. He was also a member of the First Baptist Church in Bluffton.

He had formerly resided at 220 East Washington St. in Bluffton.

Additional survivors include three sons, Bruce A. Gregg of Ossian, Robert Charles Gregg of Linthicum, Md., and William E. Gregg of Greentown; a sister, Helen V. Miller, New Castle; six grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by two brothers, Roger "Nutsy" Gregg and Jim Gregg.

Services at 10:30 a.m. Monday will be at Thoma/Rich, Hewitt & Chaney Funeral Home with Pastor Bud Abrams officiating. Burial will follow at Elm Grove Cemetery. Full military graveside rites will be by the American Legion Post # 111
