Lola B. Grimm, 89, of Poneto, passed away at 3:26 A.M. on Sunday, June 04, 2017, at her home surrounded by her family.

She was born on May 9, 1928 in Adams County, Indiana to Levi & Ocie (Poling) Strahm. She graduated from Petroleum High School in 1946. She married Harold L. Grimm on September 23, 1946 in Geneva. He preceded her in death on October 31, 2006. Lola worked alongside with Harold on the family dairy and was a member of Keystone United Methodist Church. She served on the Board of Directors for Wells County Farm Bureau and was a Democratic Prescient Committee Woman.

Lola is survived by her children; Timothy (Paula) Grimm of Berne, Mark (Jaimi) Grimm of Keystone, Linda (Charles "EZ") Harris of Poneto and Pam (Rick) Schortgen of Ossian; 11 grandchildren; 8 great-grandchildren, and one arriving soon.

She is preceded in death by a son Rodney L. Grimm.

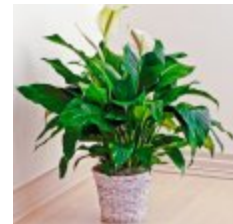

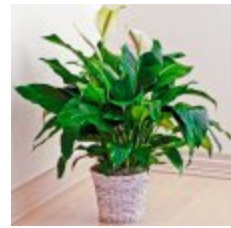
