



## Lorene Andrews

January 25, 1928 - February 28, 2008

Lorene Andrews, 80, of Bluffton, died at 6:30 a.m. Thursday, Feb. 28, 2008 at her residence.

Born in Wells County on Jan. 25, 1928 to Charles and Clara Mae (Johnson) Fosnaugh, she married Oscar Andrews in Bluffton on Nov. 1, 1946; he survives.

A 1946 graduate of Petroleum High School, Mrs. Andrews worked at Kitco for 20 years, retiring in 1985. She also worked at Franklin Electric for several years. She was a member of Park United Brethren Church.

Other surviving relatives include two sons, Christopher Andrews of Mooresville and Jon Andrews of Bluffton; one daughter, Ann Marie Pommer of Bluffton; one sister, Anna Lucille Duke of Mio, Mich.; six grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.
