June 17, 1919 - June 30, 2008

Louise Hedges, 89, of Bluffton, died Monday, June 30, 2008 at the Bluffton Regional Medical Center.

Born in Wells County on June 17, 1919 to Alfred and Zola (Stewart) Wisner, she married Charles F. Hedges on Nov. 23, 1939 in her parents' home in Wells County; he died April 22, 1991.

A 1936 graduate of Lancaster High School, she worked for many years at the Caylor-Nickel Hospital, and continued to volunteer there after her retirement.

She was a long-time member of the First Reformed Church in Bluffton.

Survivors include two daughters, Janet (Archer) Farmer of Elizabeth City, N.C., and Joyce (William) Seck of rural Craigville; two sons, William (Susan) Hedges of Prescott, Ariz. and Richard (Cindy) Hedges of Longmont, Colo.; seven grandchildren; five step-grandchildren; one great grandchild; and three step-great-grandchildren.

Services will be held Thursday at 10:30 a.m. at Thoma/Rich, Chaney & Lemler Funeral Home with Dr. Gene Bell officiating. Calling hours there are Wednesday from 2 to 8 p.m.
