Louise E. Stuff, 96, of Bluffton passed away on Monday afternoon, June 18, 2018, at her residence in Bluffton.

Louise was born on March 3, 1922 in Craigville, Indiana to Roy H. & Lillian (Smith) Deihl. She graduated from Lancaster High School with the class of 1940 and from Wayne Beauty School in Fort Wayne. Louise was the owner/operator of Louise's Beauty Shop for many years, along with being a homemaker. A longtime member of the First Presbyterian Church where she helped with Happy Hour, along with her memberships in the Bluffton Elks Lodge, American Legion Post #111 Auxiliary and the Parlor City Country Club. On October 25, 1941 in Attica, Indiana, Louise and Leonard L. Stuff were married. He preceded her in death on June 27, 1989.
