Magdalene R. Hogg, 96, of Bluffton, died at 12:30 p.m. Tuesday, Nov. 29, 2011, at her residence with her family.

She was born on Aug. 17, 1915, in Rock Creek Township to John T. and Ida C. (Baumgardner) Oldfather. She married Wendell Hogg on Jan. 19, 1939, in Wells County. They shared 61 years of marriage before he passed away on Sept. 22, 2000.

A 1933 graduate of Rockcreek High School, Mrs. Hogg worked at Uniondale Elevator, the 4-H office in Bluffton, and with J.L. Goodin, Don Kaade, and also with Larry Hiday at Hiday Motors Inc., where she retired in 1998.

Mrs. Hogg was a lifelong member of the First Reformed Church in Bluffton.
