Marcella E. DeBolt, 91, of Bluffton, IN, went to heaven on Thursday morning November 12, 2020, at the River Terrace Retirement Community.

Marcella was born on January 30, 1929, in Wabash County to Howard and Flossie Estelle (Gunter) Tyner. She was a 1947 graduate of Chester High School in North Manchester, IN. 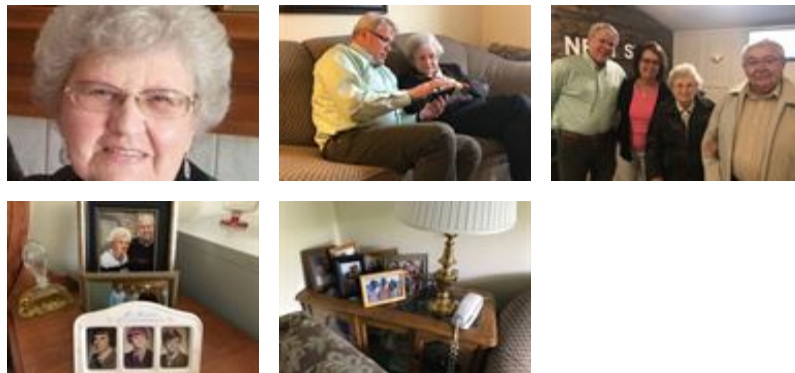
