



## Margaret Hahn

February 24, 1921 - March 11, 2009

Margaret Lottie Ellen Hahn, 88, Markle, died at 3:15 p.m. Wednesday at Heritage Pointe in Warren. Mrs. Hahn was a beautician for several years at the Micklitsch Beauty Salon. She operated her own shop, Margaret's Beauty Salon, for 30 years. She also cut residents' hair at the Fort Wayne State School for several years. She was a member of the Psi Iota Xi sorority and was a member of First Baptist Church. She was a graduate of Jackson Township High School. She received her beautician's training at Wayne University, graduating in 1946. During her children's school years, she was very active in the P.T. A. She was an avid bowler and artist. She was born Feb. 24, 1921, in Wells County, to Dustin E. Spaulding and Violet Lucille Matson Spaulding. She married William F. Hahn Aug. 5, 1944, in Norfolk, Va.; her husband died March 5, 2004.
