Marjorie E. Priser, 84, of Bremen, and a former resident of Bluffton, passed away on Saturday, February 23, 2019, at Signature Health Care in Bremen.

She was born in Fort Wayne, Indiana on December 3, 1934 to Ralph H. & Fern I. (Harris) Smith and married Floyd E. Priser on July 19, 1958 and he preceded her in death on February 12, 2008.

A 1953 graduate of Butler High School, Mrs. Priser lived in Adams County from 1964 to 1985 and then moved to Bluffton. She worked in the admission office at Caylor-Nickel Clinic and in the dietary department of Christian Care Retirement Community. In 2003 she moved to Bremen to be closer to her family. Marjorie was a longtime member of Pleasant Dale Church of the Brethren.
