Martha Louise Robles, 85, of Bluffton, died at 1:55 p.m. Saturday, May 8, 2010, at the Bluffton Regional Medical Center. Mrs. Robles was a homemaker and also worked at Magnavox for more than 25 years. She was an active member of the Harvest Time Bible Church, where she served as secretary/treasurer of the executive board for 18 years and also served as a Sunday school teacher. She was a graduate of P.A. Allen (Bluffton) High School. A lifelong resident of Wells County, she was born Nov. 13, 1924, in Bluffton, to Dwight L. Sliger and Nellie Marie Huss Sliger.
