Mary Jo Brink, 90, of Bluffton, passed away on Monday afternoon, August 20, 2018, at River Terrace Estates in Bluffton.

She was born on September 28, 1927 in Indianapolis, Indiana to Ramon H. & May Doreen (McEnaney) Browder. She graduated from Shortridge High School and completed college classes for over 2 years at both Purdue & Butler University.

Mary Jo was a longtime member of the First Presbyterian Church in Bluffton along with Alpha Chi Omega and Tri Kappa Sorority.

On November 19, 1955 in Indianapolis, Mary Jo and Lawrence H. Brink were married. They shared 37 years together before he preceded her in death on December 8, 1992.

A homemaker, Mary Jo work at the Bluffton State Farm Insurance Office for 15 years, retiring in 1989.

Survivors include two sons; William H. Brink and Daniel J. (Jennifer) Brink, both of Bluffton along with 7 grandchildren and 4 great-grandchildren.

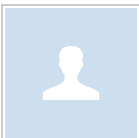
