Mary M. Kizer, 93, of Bluffton passed away on Saturday afternoon, December 8, 2018, at River Terrace Estates in Bluffton.

Mary was born on September 29, 1925 in Bluffton, Indiana to James Murray “Sharkey” and Sylvia (Boxell) Thornburg. She graduated from Bluffton High School in 1943. After working in the office at General Electric, Mary graduated from the Indiana Real Estate School and Bill Miller’s School of Real Estate where she held the GRI designation. She was a real estate broker and owner of Kizer Realty in Bluffton with her husband for 21 years.

Mary was a member of the First Church of the Nazarene in Bluffton where she was awarded Distinguish Service Award in the Church of the Nazarene, Sunday School teacher and was active in the Migrant and Literacy Programs. She was also a member of the Bluffton Lions Club, Gideon’s Auxiliary member. She was a Girl Scout Leader and served as President of Lauback Literacy Club for many years.

On June 10, 1945, Mary and Cloyd Donovan “Jerry” Kizer were married at The Nazarene Church in Bluffton and he precedes her in death on April 16, 2004.

Surviving are her daughters; Nancy Hayes of Washington, MO and Janet (Tom) Lloyd of Peru, IN, 6 grandchildren, 4 great-grandchildren and one son-in-law James Hayes of MO.

Funeral services for Mary will be held at 2 P.M. on Thursday (December 13, 2018) at the First Church of the Nazarene in Bluffton with Rev. Mike Hershey

officiating. Burial will take place at Six Mile Cemetery in Bluffton.

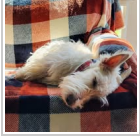

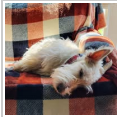
