Mary Esther Line, 90, formerly of Markle, died Monday, February 16, 2009 at Swiss Village in Berne.

Born in Wells County on March 11, 1918, to Charles and Mary Elizabeth "Molly" (Reece) Inskip, she married Arthur Line on June 30, 1939, in Markle. Arthur died in 1991. Two siblings, Dorothea Rochon, and Virginia Lieurance, and great-grandchild, Alicia Meekin, also preceded her in death.
