Formerly of Bluffton, Mary Jane Hammond, 88, died March 28, 2007, in West Lafayette, where she had lived since July 2006.

Mrs. Hammond was a full-time homemaker. She obtained her degree as an English major in 1939 from Kansas University. She lived in Wells County from 1967 to 2006. She was active in the Bluffton Garden Club and was a Red Cross volunteer. She volunteered at both Caylor-Nickel and Wells Community hospitals. Mrs. Hammond was a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Bluffton.

Born June 6, 1918, in Coffeyville, Kan., to the late Maurice V. and Mary Bess (Davis) Perkins, her marriage on Sept. 14, 1946, in Overland Park, Kan., was to Ralph A. Hammond, who preceded her in death on Dec. 29, 2004.
