August 14, 1923 - April 1, 2009

Mary Jane Showalter, 85, of Bluffton, died at 11:30 a.m. Wednesday, April 1, 2009, at Markle Health Care. Mrs. Showalter was born Aug. 14, 1923, in Wells County, to Karl Hannie and Matilda Reinhart Hannie. She married Ward D. Showalter in Bluffton on Nov. 10, 1945; he preceded her in death Jan. 24, 1979.

Mrs. Showalter graduated from Bluffton High School in the class of 1941. She was a member of the Keystone United Methodist Church and Quarterly Club. Surviving relatives include two sons, Ted (Tammy) Showalter of Keystone and Kenneth Showalter of Indianapolis, and a daughter, Kathy Showalter of Dayton, Ohio.

Mrs. Showalter was also preceded in death by a sister, Kathleen Schlagenhauf, and two brothers, Kenneth Hannie and Robert Hannie.
