



## Mary Jane Passmore Harris

November 23, 1915 - December 16, 2008

Mary Jane Passmore Harris, 93, Bluffton, died at 6:15 a.m. Tuesday, Dec. 16, 2008, at Christian Care Retirement Community.

She was born Nov. 23, 1915, in Van Buren, to Ross and Margaret (Green) Passmore. She married James O. Harris June 22, 1940, in Marion; her husband died Sept. 18, 2004. She was a 1932 graduate of Jefferson Center High School in Huntington County and also graduated from Marion Business College.

She was a housewife and also assisted her husband on the family farm. She worked in the accounting

department at Caylor-Nickel Clinic for five years in the 1960s, at the Hoosier Grain & Supply Co.,

at Producer's Creamery in Marion, and in the Wells County Clerk's office. She was a 57-year member of the First United Methodist Church and was a member of the Wells County Home Economics Club for a number of years.

Survivors include a son, Richard E. (Terry) Harris of Bluffton; a daughter, Lois Jean (Keith) Gallaway of New Mexico; and five grandchildren and six great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her husband and a grandson Kurt Richard Harris on May 1, 1985.
