December 24, 1923 - October 10, 2009

Mary Lucile Grubb, 85, Bluffton, died of natural causes at 5:35 p.m. Saturday, October 10, 2009 at the Bluffton Regional Medical Center. Born in Wells County on December 24, 1923 to John W. and Josie B. (Mounsey) Musselman, she lived most of her life in Wells County except from 1964 to 1969 when she resided in California. A 1942 graduate of Liberty Center High School where she was the salutatorian of her class, she owned and operated Grubb's Flower Shop in Warren for ten years. She worked in the Food Service Department at Caylor-Nickel Clinic for eleven years, retiring in 1988. Mrs. Grubb crocheted several table cloths to raise money for the Wells County Council on Aging. "She lived her life for her family and was known in the community for her kindness and sweetness." Survivors include four children, Terrance (Vivian) Grubb of Fort Wayne, Gary (Barbara) Grubb of Bluffton, Cynthia Heaton of Tucson, Ariz., and Angela (Dennis) Ealing of Ossian; two sisters, Helen Hamilton of Poneto and Garnett Parsons of Eaton; nine grandchildren; 15 great grandchildren; and one great-great grandson. She was preceded in death by two brothers, Paul and David Musselman, six sisters, Nova Minnich, Hattie Musselman, Frances Musselman, Florence Hunnicutt, Mabel Penrod and Grace Creek; and a grandson, Jason Paul Ealing on Dec. 11, 2003. Calling hours are Tuesday from 3 to 8 p.m. and Wednesday for one hour prior to the service, all to be held at the Thoma/Rich, Chaney & Lemler Funeral Home in Bluffton. Services are Wednesday at 10:30 a.m. with Pastor Gary Aupperle officiating. Burial will be in the McFarren
