



Mary Margaret Sellers

January 11, 1913 - October 12, 2006

A longtime teacher in Wells and Blackford counties, Mary Margaret Sellers, 93, of Poneto died at 8:08 p.m. Thursday, Oct. 12, 2006, at River Terrace Estates.

Miss Sellers retired in 1979 from the Blackford County School system after a 47-year career in teaching. She began in a two-room school in Vera Cruz, then spent 13 years teaching grades 3 and 4 at Poplar Grove before going to Montpelier, where she taught fourth grade for 33 years.

She attended Poneto United Methodist Church and was a member of Psi Iota Xi Sorority, Business & Professional Women Association, Delta Kappa Gamma, Wells County Hospital Auxiliary, Blackford County Teachers Association, Indiana State Retired Teachers Association, Wells County Retired Teachers Association and the Blackford-Wells County Genealogy Society.

Born on Jan. 11, 1913, near Poneto, she was a daughter of Emory Bing Sellers and Nora L. (Doyle) Sellers. She was a graduate of Petroleum High School, with additional training at Manchester College and Ball State University.

Survivors include a sister, Dorothea D. Sellers of Poneto. She was preceded in death by a sister, Ruth R. Sellers; and a brother, Leroy Thomas Sellers.

Private family services will be held. There is no calling. Graveside services will be at Van Buren Cemetery with Rev. Roy Nevil officiating.
