Mavis L. Walters, 80, of Bluffton, died at 6:49 p.m. Thursday, Feb. 7, 2008, at Parkview Hospital in Fort Wayne. Mavis loved God, and was looking forward to her eternal heavenly home. Born in Peru to George and Mabel (Boyd) Gehring on April 23, 1927, she married Robert E. Walters in Peru on Dec. 11, 1948; he preceded her in death in June, 1994.

A 1946 graduate of Peru High School, Mrs. Walters then graduated from Wodekind's Beauty School in Logansport and worked in a beauty salon until her marriage. Together with her husband, she owned and operated Bob's Truck Caps, where she worked as a bookkeeper, and also helped install truck caps for 15 years. She was a member of the First Church of the Nazarene in Bluffton.

Surviving relatives include a son, Blake (Vicky) Walters of Bluffton; a daughter, Evonne (Richard) Stephens of Fort Wayne; a brother, George (Sherry) Gehring of Peru; three grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

Mrs. Walters was also preceded in death at birth by a set of twins, a boy and a girl; and her sister, Kate (Gehring) Martin.

Funeral services will be at 11 a.m. Monday, Feb 11 at the Thoma/Rich, Chaney & Lemler Funeral Home in Bluffton, with the Rev. Larry Sheets officiating.
