Maxine L. Spaid, 101 of Bluffton passed away at 3:13 a.m. Monday, November 24, 2014, at River Terrace Estates in Bluffton.

She was born on August 8, 1913 in Markle, Indiana to Sylvester & Rose (Alshouse) Lesh. She was a graduate of the 1931 class of Markle High School and was an honorary member of Alpha Nu Chapter of the Psi Iota Xi Sorority in Markle. She was a 20 year retiree of J.C. Penney's in Bluffton and a member of the First United Methodist Church and the Poplar Grove Home Demonstration Club.

On January 1, 1941 in Dunkirk, Maxine and Woodrow E. Spaid were married. They shared 63 years together before he preceded her in death in 2004.

Maxine was also preceded in death by a sister Ruth Stark.
