



Mr. Melvin Dean Welker

July 20, 1933 - August 11, 2014

Melvin "Dean" Welker, 81 of Ossian passed away at 10:00 p.m. Monday, August 11, 2014, at Bluffton Regional Medical Center.

Dean was born on July 20, 1933 in Huntington County. He graduated from Jefferson High School in 1951. On June 29, 1952 he married V. Arlene (Pressler) Welker at the Mt. Etna United Methodist Church, where burial will take place in the church cemetery.

He is survived by his wife Arlene of Ossian along with a son Jeff Welker of Ossian, 6 grandchildren, 12 great-grandchildren and 2 great-great-grandchildren. Dean was preceded in death by a son Dennis Welker on October 6, 2010.

Dean retired in 1995 from Dana Corp. in Fort Wayne where he worked for many years. He was a very active member of the Bluffton Masonic Lodge #145, where he was a Past Master. He also held offices in the Eastern Star at both the local and state level. He was also a member of the Scottish Rite and Shrine in Fort Wayne.
