Merrill A. Myers, 77, of Keystone, died from cancer at 3 a.m. Thursday, Oct. 21, at his residence.

Mr. Myers was born in Howard County on May 23, 1933, to Carl C. and Freida P. (Graham) Myers. He married Janice A. Myers in Redkey on April 27, 1954; she survives.

A 1951 graduate of Eastern High School in Greentown, Mr. Myers earned a journeyman's degree from Purdue University. He had been self-employed since 1964, when he was the owner/operator of Grain Equipment Company. He later moved into the business of Industrial Equipment Sales. He owned and operated the Equipment Warehouse until he became ill in May, 2010.

Mr. Myers was a U.S. Army veteran, and a member of American Legion Post #111. He was also a member of Petroleum United Methodist Church.

Surviving relatives include one son, Steve (Rhonda) Myers of Bluffton; three daughters, Cheryl (John) Aschliman of Bluffton, Karen (Dave) Lewis of Ossian, and Jennifer (Mike) Pursifull of Keystone; three brothers, Byron D. Myers of Pierceton, Clyde "Bill" Myers of Elwood, and Darol B. Myers of Bluffton; one sister, Markeeta (Roger) Wilson of Bluffton; 11 grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren.

Mr. Myers was preceded in death by one daughter, Tamara K. Myers; and one great-granddaughter, Elexia Lillian Kahn.
