November 14, 1991 - January 28, 2012

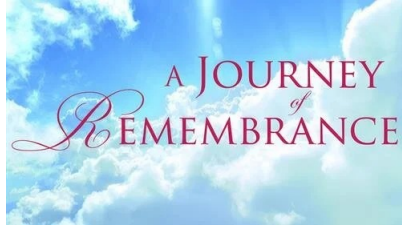
Michael M. Brindle, 20, Bluffton, died at 10:10 p.m. Saturday, Jan. 28, 2012 at Bluffton Regional Medical Center. Born in Bluffton on Nov. 14, 1991, he graduated from Norwell High School in 2010 and was attending Ivy Tech. He was a line cook at Corner Depot and also worked for the Wells County Voice. Michael played football for Norwell for two years and was an avid Green Bay Packers fan. He was currently serving as the 6th grade assistant football coach at Southern Wells. He was a former member and officer of the FFA, a ten-year member of the Wells County Horse and Pony Club, a ten-year member of 4-H, and was active in Campus Life. He was an avid hunter and outdoorsman.

Michael was baptized at Fountain Church where he was a member. Survivors include his mother, Angela Decker and her fiancé, Leslie "Bucket" Wyss of Ossian; a sister, Katie D. Brindle of Bluffton; grandparents, Fred and Elisabeth Bledsoe of Ossian; and a great-grandparent, Madeline Brindle of Bluffton. He was preceded in death by a grandfather, Donald E. "Mouse" Brindle on Oct. 22, 2000 and great-grandparents, Forrest Brindle, and Joseph and Darlene Scaffa. 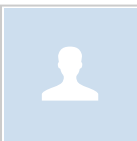


“ *Angie,*

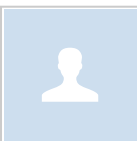
