Mildred A. Huss, 94 of Bluffton, passed away on Sunday morning, February 14, 2021, at Christian Care Retirement Community in Bluffton.

She was born on February 24, 1926 in Bluffton, Indiana to Glen R. & Dorothy L. (Lydy) Johnson. Mildred was a van driver for ARC – Bi County Services in Bluffton for over 30 years and Poplar Grove Schools for 4 years. She was a member of the First Baptist Church in Bluffton and the American Legion Post #111 Auxiliary for over 75 years.

On November 3, 1945 in Bluffton, Mildred and Earl L. Huss were married. Survivors include sons; Dave (Margie) Huss of Ossian, Don (Vicky) Huss and Doug Huss of Bluffton and 10 grandchildren, 36 great-grandchildren and 17 great-great-grandchildren along with a brother, Herman A. (Pat) Schroeder of Fort Wayne.

She is preceded in death by her parents, husband Earl, a son Dan Huss, a daughter, Diann E. Huss, two daughter-in-laws Judy Huss and Mar Huss along with four grandchildren; Stephanie Huss, Angela McHenry and Meredith McCarter, and Walter “Joe” Huss, a great-grandson, Justin McHenry and a sister, Anna L. Voght.

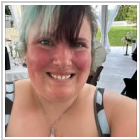
