Nancy A. Heyne, 69, of Bluffton, died at 10:02 a.m. Tuesday, May 20, 2008, at her home.

Born in Auglaize County, Ohio on July 29, 1938 to Wilson J. and Esther (Becker) Maurer, she married Oscar L. Heyne in Bluffton on Oct. 16, 1976; he survives.

A 1956 graduate of New Breman High School, Mrs. Heyne graduated from Indiana University in 1980. She was a case worker in Allen and Wells Counties, and most recently served as Activity Director at Heritage Pointe in Warren for 12 years. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church, Tri-Kappa and the Study Club at the church.
