



## Nicholas K. Dunn

November 7, 1952 - December 30, 2024

Nicholas K. Dunn, 72 of Ossian, passed away on Monday evening, December 30, 2024, at Stillwater Hospice Home in Fort Wayne.

Nick was born on November 7, 1952 in Bluffton to Everett J. “Junior” and Doris J. (Tarr) Dunn. He graduated from Southern Wells High School in 1971. He started working for Bowmar LLC in Waynedale. He then moved to Lafayette to work for Caterpillar as a quality control operator, where he was a self-taught computer programmer. Nick eventually moved to Sanford, NC to continue working for Caterpillar in Quality Control before retiring in 2015. Upon retirement, Nick returned to Ossian to be closer to family.

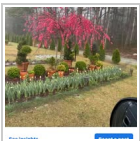

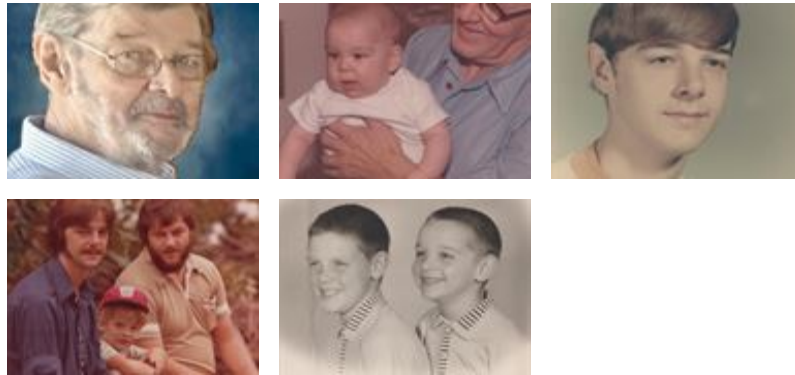
